

WORLD WAR II BOLT ACTION PRACTICE MATCH

Date: Saturday, August 20, 2005, immediately after our regular match.

Match summary: This match is intended as structured practice session for the World War II Bolt Action Rifle Match to be held Sunday, September 4, 2004. However, this practice match is open to all rifles. Scores from WW II bolt rifles will be listed separately from the scores of other rifles.

Fee: None. This is a club “bonus” event open to all Zouaves at no additional cost.

Course of fire:

This course of fire is an abbreviated version of the World War II Bolt Action match.

Sighter stage: Three minute preparation period followed by unlimited sighters in five minutes.

Stage 1, Standing: 10 rounds in five minutes on the 200 yard target.

Stage 2, Sitting: 10 rounds in three minutes on the 200 yard target.

Stage 3, Prone: 10 rounds in five minutes on the 300 yard target.

Use of stripper clips permitted. Rifles need not be single round loaded.

No alibis or saved rounds. They did not get them in WW II.
