

TIME AND ACCURACY MATCH

FEBRUARY 19, 2005 COURSE OF FIRE

In today's match each competitor will take a total of six shots from three positions plus the opportunity to take an optional untimed seventh shot. For the "option" shot there are additional rewards for hitting the target but additional penalties for missing the target. Targets are placed at from 100 to 200 yards. See schematic for target placement.

The match is open to any rifle (no magnums) including rifles with bipods and either iron or optical sights. No AP or steel core ammo allowed. Individuals may fire the course as often as they like.

To assist the competitors the match time keeper will walk each competitor through the course while they shoot it.

1. **Prone.** Competitors start standing at **position 9**. At the signal "TIME" the shooter takes the **prone** position, loads two rounds and takes one shot at each of the **two black targets**. After the second shot the competitor immediately moves to position 15.
2. **Standing.** At **position 15**, the competitor remains standing, loads two rounds and takes one shot at the **orange target** and one shot at the **orange gong** to the right of position 16. After the second shot the competitor immediately moves to **position 12**.
3. **Sitting or kneeling.** At position 12 the competitor takes either a **sitting or kneeling** position, loads two rounds and takes one shot at each of the **two white targets**.

Time ends with the last (sixth) shot. The competitor's score at this point is the total time to take the six shots plus one minute added for each missed shot. The competitor may accept his score at this point or choose to take the "option" shot.

4. **Option shot.** If the competitor chooses to take the option shot and hits the target he will have one minute subtracted from his score. If he misses the shot he will have one minute added to his score.

In today's match the option shot is to be taken **prone** from **position 7** at the small **red gong**.
