

SAN JOSE ZOUAVES SLOWFIRE PRACTICE

Time and Date: Various, Immediately after the morning match. No additional fee.

Match Summary: The primary purpose of this event is to provide participants with structured practice time for any type of slowfire shooting with any type of rifle.

Course of fire:

Before the first string, participants will be asked whether they are shooting prone or standing. Prone shooters will shoot at a 600 yard simulated target. Standing shooters will shoot at a 200 yard target. After each string is complete, shooters will be provided an opportunity to switch target types before targets are reposted.

Sighter Stage: Three minute preparation period followed by five minutes for unlimited sighters.

Record stage: Twenty two minutes for twenty record shots in a combined preparation and record stage.

This practice match is open to any rifle and any sight. The class of rifle and shooting position for each string will be noted with the scores. Rifle classifications are as follows:

Classes of Rifles:

- Match rifle - Match grade bolt rifles, space guns, open sights.
- Modern Service Rifle - M1A, AR15, match grade M1s, open sights.
- Classic Service Rifle, .30-06 M1 Garand, including M1D, .03-A3, No. 4 Enfield.
- Scoped Rifle - Any rifle with a scope. Rifles in this class may use a front rest such as a benchrest front rest, bi-pod, sand bags, etc., no rear support.
- Vintage - Pre World War II era rifles with issue sights, i.e., no match sights or scopes. Includes WW I era .03s.
